World Art Forum for Development Foundation (WAFDF) and the National Institute for Governance and Sustainable Development (NIGSD) (the training arm of the Ministry of Planning and Economic Development) signed a Memorandum of Understanding to collaborate on sustainable development initiatives.

The MoU was signed by Ms. Randa Fouad, WAFDF President, and Dr. Sherifa Sherif, NIGSD Managing Director. Fouad stated that art is a universal language and an active partner in sustainable development which lies at the heart of the Foundation's mission.

Fouad expressed her excitement to collaborate with the National Institute for Governance and Sustainable

Development after signing a partnership protocol for the implementation of the Sustainable Art and Human

Development Initiative in cooperation with several ministries, United Nations agencies, and the private sector.

The Initiative focuses on the role of fine art in the form of recycled art in supporting youth and women through a series of workshops, creative contests, and exhibitions that revolve around 3 pillars: sustainable art and handicrafts, entrepreneurship, and the Sustainable Development Goals within the Egypt 2030 strategy.
